Provide comprehensive management of high-risk patients



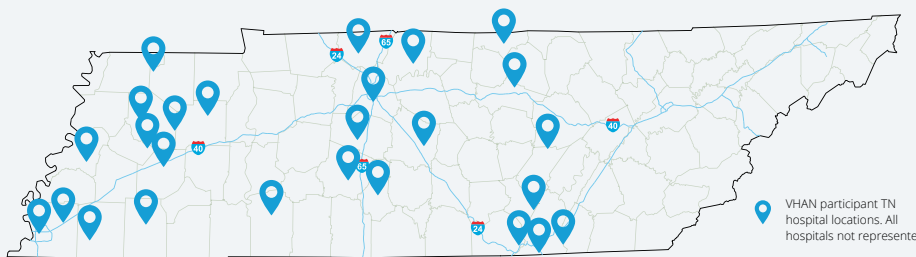
